ABOUT NEWARK PRIDE

Organization History

Since its founding in 2005, Newark Pride, Inc. has been a steadfast advocate for visibility, equity, and empowerment within Newark's LGBTQIA+ community. The organization was established in the wake of the tragic murder of Sakia Gunn, a 15-year-old Black lesbian who was fatally attacked in downtown Newark in 2003. Her death exposed the urgent need for safer spaces, greater protections, and stronger representation for LGBTQIA+ individuals—particularly Black and Brown queer youth. In response, Newark Pride emerged as a force for social change, dedicated to fostering a city where LGBTQIA+ individuals can live openly and thrive.

Impact on the Newark LGBTQ+ Community

- Newark LGBTQ+ Pride Week serves as a major platform for visibility, connection, and economic empowerment, drawing thousands to the Downtown Business District.
- Strengthens local businesses and fosters inclusive partnerships with corporate allies.
- Leads policy discussions, social justice efforts, and grassroots organizing to ensure LGBTQIA+ representation in Newark's growth and development.




Key Initiatives and Year-Round Programming
